Fast Facts about Lottie Moon Offering

World evangelism

11,573 million people groups worldwide; 6.6 billion people
 6,508 unreached people groups; 3.8 billion people. Unreached = less than 2 percent evangelical, active church planting
 3,340 unreached, unengaged people groups; 471.3 million people. Unreached, unengaged = less than 2 percent evangelical; no active church planting.

Church growth (as reported in the 2007 Annual Statistical Report)

25,497 new churches (compared to 3,352 in 1997)
 609,968 new baptisms (compared to 308,398 in 1997)
 567,413 new believers in discipleship

Missionaries

5,317 (as of 6/26/08)
 1,081 short-term missionaries
 4,236 long term (career) missionaries

Lottie Moon

2008 goal: \$170 million
 2007 receipts: 150.4 million
 \$3.0 billion given since the offering was begun
 \$3,315 collected in 1888 for first offering

79 percent Roman Catholic; 6 percent evangelical; 15 percent nonreligious/other
 355 million do not know Christ
 699 total people groups (IMB missionaries work among 87)
 200 people groups with no evangelical presence

Funding for Missions

Lottie Moon Christmas Offering

Every penny given to the Lottie Moon offering is used to support Southern Baptist missionaries as they share the Gospel overseas. The offering represents nearly 50 percent of the International Mission Board's (IMB's) total income each year.

Cooperative Program

More than 33 percent of the IMB's income is received from the Southern Baptist Convention's Cooperative Program (CP). Our church gives its CP offering to the state convention. Each convention gives between 13 percent and 54 percent of its CP collection to the SBC. The SBC gives 50 percent of that amount to the IMB and 50 percent to other SBC entities, including the North American Mission Board.

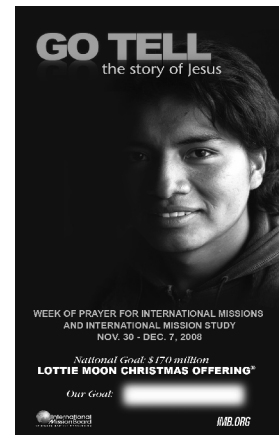
Other Income

Southern Baptists' gifts to the IMB's World Hunger and General Relief ministries comprise 6 percent of the IMB's income. Field-generated funds, investment returns and other income constitute the remaining 11 percent.
